



Health Leadership Council Overview

Purpose

The TSBGH Health Leadership Council has been established as a vehicle for high-level discussion of issues important to coalition members and to all the major parties in health care – purchasers, providers, insurers, representatives and suppliers. The dialogue itself is the most immediate value of membership – the opportunity to educate each other on our respective concerns including, but not limited to, quality of care, access to care, and affordability of care.

Eligible Health Leadership Council Members (*List not exhaustive*)

Hospitals, Physician Practices, Pharmacy Benefit Managers, Health Plans, Ancillary Healthcare Providers (Physical Therapy, Diagnostic Imaging, Home Health Care, Durable Medical Equipment, Infusion, etc.), Insurance Brokers, Benefit Consultants, Pharmaceutical Manufacturers, Third Party Administrators, Preferred Provider Organizations/Networks

Health Leadership Council Member Benefits

- Participation in two meetings per year with TSBGH Board of Directors.
- Participation in “full membership” meetings of TSBGH.
- Eligibility for “member” prices for meeting registrations and other products and services such as the annual benefits survey reports.
- Eligibility to access TSBGH group purchasing programs for additional \$500 annual dues for companies with 249 or fewer employees and additional \$1,000 annual dues for companies with 250 or more employees.
- Acknowledgement on the TSBGH website.

Health Leadership Council Guidelines

- Health Leadership Council members are not “voting” members in TSBGH and are not eligible to serve on the Board of Directors.
- Each Health Leadership Council member company can bring up to two representatives to each “Health Leadership Council” meeting (two will be held per year) and each “full membership” meeting with the exception of the Annual Meeting. There are no limits to participation at the Annual Meeting.
- Health Leadership Council membership is subject to approval by the Board of Directors.
- Health Leadership Council membership is separate for each operating entity within a parent organization or corporate system.
- Health Leadership Council membership is not an endorsement by TSBGH of that entity’s products or services.
- Attendance at TSBGH meetings should not be used for marketing or solicitation of the products or services of a Health Leadership Council member. Violation will result in termination of membership privileges.
